

PEE WEE BEEF SHOW



1. Young children not in 4-H, but at least 5 years old are eligible to show a bucket bottle calf.
2. Bucket bottle calf is defined as any orphan or newborn calf born between Feb. 15 and fair. Exhibitor may borrow a 4-H's bucket bottle calf. If exhibitor brings their own in for the day, it must be kept away from the other cattle unless examined by the fair vet.
3. This class will start at 8:45 a.m. prior to the regular 4-H classes on Friday, July 14.
4. All entries will be paraded before the judge and placed on the basis of showmanship.
5. No entry fees are required, but the below liability must be signed by parent or guardian prior to the start of the class.
6. All contestants will receive ribbons.
